OVO and Bijou In 2018, when she was starting to elaborate her business model, Bijou participated in

a 3-day boostcamp given by OVO and then benefited from a 5-month coaching. This enabled her to:

• define the offer and the target

• estimate the investment costs and the team needed

• prepare her pitch to investors

She obtained a financing agreement in the form of a loan from OVO in 2019 for the sum of € 44.000 (out of € 75.000 total project costs). Bijou is in the second year

of repayment.
