

# Cookie policy

## What is a Cookie?

Cookies are small text files that remember users' preferences while surfing and store them on the user's own computer or system. We use cookies to remember preferences. You can disable these cookies via your browser but this may have a negative impact on how our website works.

There are several types of cookies, depending on their origin, function and lifespan:

## What cookies are used?

- Temporary or session cookies are only used temporarily during the sessions and are deleted when users close their web browser.
- Permanent cookies stay on the computer even when the user closes the browser. Permanent cookies allow the user to be recognized during subsequent visits to the website. Permanent cookies stay on your device until their end date is reached, until a new cookie is installed, or until you remove them in the settings of your browser, application or mobile device.

Most browsers support them (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Netscape, Safari, etc.). Users can set their browser to refuse cookies or they can remove them.

pll_language	The purpose of the cookie is to record the last language used.	PolyLang (WordPress plugin)	1 year
wfvt_2383926179	Purpose of the cookie: Records the duration so that the web pages can be grouped together.	WordFence (WordPress plugin)	Session
wordfence_verifiedHuman	Purpose of the cookie: repeling bots on the site.	WordFence (WordPress plugin)	1 day

wp-settings-1	Purpose of the cookie: the number at the end is the individual UID and is kept for admin reasons.	WordPress	Session
wp-settings-time-1	Purpose of the cookie: the number at the end is the individual UID and is kept for admin reasons.	WordPress	Session
cookie-notice	Purpose of the cookie: records when the user accepts the cookie policy.	WordPress	1 year

## Blocking or removing cookies

If users choose via their browser to refuse to have some or all cookies installed, websites may work less well. It is better to switch off just the unwanted cookies selectively. Users can do this in the settings of their web browser. By doing this users also immediately block the cookies from other websites they visit.
